Notes and Suggestions

This “brochure” is designed for easy modification, printing, and providing to event attendees.

You can print enough to hand out at the event, or you might to send them out ahead of time if you want people to know the opportunity will be available.

You might want to personalize it a little such as typing in the name of your organization where the document now says, “We”.

The wording in the last paragraph assumes that you will have some toys at the event so you can show them to people, and then “take orders” for later delivery or providing at a location convenient to your attendees. Of course, it is always better if you have toys right there on the spot, but that requires you to purchase them ahead of time and guess how many you will need. If you can’t do that, try to come up with the simplest possible way to put the toys in their hands after the event. You can modify that portion of the page as needed.

You can also add your organization's name and address to the top of the coupon so you can then photo-copy it and give it to them as a receipt when they pick up the toys (or you deliver them...).

Be sure to have someone available (children are the best) to demonstrate the toys, especially the “Coin Limbo” game. Be sure to let people try it so they can get hooked on the fun. (Hint: Have a smooth table next to the floor-model Well so the Coin Limbo game can be played with the toy flat.
